Match 1 Kursk

Trinity: Usual format. Fig 12; 15 rounds one minute per position.

Match 2 Stalingrad

Shoot the Oberst then take out the Grenadiers: One steel plate at 100 m and a figure 12 at 100m

You have 12 shots, when you hit the plate you can engage the fig 12 with your remaining rounds. As soon as the plate is down any remaining rounds may be shot at your figure 12. 45 seconds for semis 1 minute for bolt guns. Position is standing until the plate is hit then you may adopt any position. Figure 12.

Match 3 Kalashnikov. (Stand-alone match, only for AK rifles)

Start Standing behind the rifle with up to 30 rounds in magazine, magazine out of rifle, bolt closed on empty chamber. On command run to mound, load and engage 100m target from any position. 30 seconds, Figure 12.

Match 4: Take the Reichstag Start at 100 m mark fire five shots prone weak handed, advance to 75m and fire 5 shots sitting, advance to 50m and fire 5 shots kneeling or squatting, advance to the 25m mark and fire 5 shots standing weak hand. 40 seconds per position. Rifles will be cleared and when the command is given all shooters will advance to the next mark; loading may only be done when you reach the next mark, time includes moving and loading. Figure 12.

Match 5: Stand for the Motherland Start prone with bolt out of rifle. On command insert bolt and load rifle, stand and fire 10 shots. 60 seconds. Figure 12. 100m. An extra 5 points is given if bolt is out of the rifle when the cease fire is given.

Match 6: Shotgun Plates

10 Plates usual format. Lead shot only.

Eligibility: Unless otherwise stated, the trophies are for communist manufactured firearms in Warsaw pact calibres, 7.62 x 39 and 7.62 x 54r. Exceptions as noted below include vz52 in 7.62 x 45 and Rashid's. All matches are iron sights except match 1 which as per Michael Dobson's instructions many years ago includes Moisin Nagant sniper rifles, Tokarov SVT rifles and Dragunov rifles. Please note Valmet's and other non-communist, non 7.62 x 39 AK's are eligible for the Kalashnikov trophy but not for the overall Red Star day trophy. The Norinco M305 in 7.62 Nato is not eligible. Confused? Feel free to email me: john@nzzrac.co.nz Just remember all rifles are welcome but only qualifying rifles are eligible for trophies.

Trophies for

Best Kalashnikov (this includes Valmet, Galil & VZ58) (Match 3)

Best Simonov (includes SKK, Rashid & VZ52 & 52/57) (Match 4)

Trophy for best military rifle chambered in 7.62 X 54R. (Match 1)

Red Star winner matches 1, 2, 4 & 5

To compete for the Red Star trophy, you must nominate one firearm and use it in all matches so this means you may end up shooting twice in some matches.
