Set up from 12.30am, competition starts at 1 pm. Range fee \$10.00



#### Match 1: Five Static Clays:

Target: Five 4 inch square light steel plates

Ammunition: Six rounds lead Birdshot No4 max.

Score: Time factored to give match points out of 50

Match: Start standing with gun loaded with six rounds, held below hips pointing downrange and with elbows straight. On command engage targets. Pates up = +5 secs

#### Match 2: Ten Static Clays:

Target: ten 4 inch square light steel plates

Ammunition: Twelve rounds lead Birdshot No4 max.

Score: Time factored to give match points out of 50

Match: Start standing with gun loaded with six rounds, held below hips pointing downrange and with elbows straight. On command engage targets. Pates up = +5 secs

#### Match 3: Shotgun Action H:

Target: Five 4 inch square light steel plates

Ammunition: Five rounds lead Birdshot No4 max.

Score: 5 points per plate

Match: Start standing with gun loaded with five rounds. On command engage plates: one shot standing, one prone, then one sitting or kneeling weak handed. Change to strong hand and then shoot one shot standing and one shot prone.

Time: 30 secs (Squads of 2 or more depending on how many plates we have)

#### Match 4: Take the Trench:

Target: Five 4 inch square coloured light steel plates

Ammunition: Unlimited Birdshot No4 max.

Score: 5 points per plate

Match: Ammo is placed in supplied ammo can, the shooter will be assigned a colour prior to start. With empty shotgun and action open, on command run to the top of the 100m mound, load and engage your coloured plates from the kneeling position.

Time: 75 secs

#### Match 5: Shotgun Slugs

Target: Five coloured steel plates from 50 to 100 metres

Ammunition: Five x 12 gauge rifles slugs 7/8 ounce

Score: 10 points per plate

Match: On command, from standing, adopt any position and engage your plates as seen.

Time: 60 secs

- Open to all shotguns, but only service class shotguns will be eligible for the trophy
- A service class shotgun is one as close to a recognised military issued shotgun, ie Mossberg 590, Benelli M4 etc
- IPSC competition designed shotguns are OPEN
- Lead shot only
- Pocket. Side saddles, loop belt or dump pouch reloading only
- Match director's decision final
