Limited to 20 participants, 5 squads of 4 competitors. Pre- registrations to inrange@haratua.nz

0830 hrs	Range set up
0850 hrs	Range safety briefing
0900 hrs	Match 1 .22LR 100 yards , 3 minute time limit for unlimited sighters, with extra time permitted to get on target if necessary. 5 minutes for 10 shots to count on 300 yd NRANZ target. Competitor manual marking at conclusion of counting shots. Any .22LR rifle, any sight, any supported prone position (eg bipod, bag, sling), loading from the magazine permitted.
1030 hrs	Match 2 if time permits, .22LR 200 yards. Same conditions as Match 1.
1200hrs	Range closed to enable range set up for afternoon club shooting and lunch break.
1300hrs	Match 3. Vintage Target/Sniper Rifle 500 yards. Electronic targets, NRANZ Match format 2 convertible sighters and 10 shots to count. Vintage target/sniper rifle, manufactured prior to 1980, eg .303 Target Rifle, No4T, 6.5x55 CG63, Omark 44, Musgrave, .30-06 National Match Springfield, Enfield Envoy or Enforcer, L42A1, Steyr SSG69, Parker Hale 1200, Remington 40X. Micrometer adjustable iron sights or telescopic sight. Suppressors permitted; muzzle breaks not permitted. Prone position, sling supported.
	Match 4. Two classes to choose from – Hunter and Precision Rifle 500 yards. 2 convertible sighters and 7 shots to count for Hunter and 10 shots to count for Precision Rifle, loading from magazine permitted. Suppressors permitted; muzzle breaks not permitted. Prone position supported by folding bipod or backpack. Hunter – Factory chambering “all day carry” hunting rifle with scope, but no rear bag support permitted. Scope set to maximum 10x magnification. All up carry weight limit 4.5kg. Scores bullseye 5 and V. Precision Rifle – NRANZ F-PR rules, calibre not exceeding .308, maximum weight 9.6kg, rear bag support permitted. Scores bullseye 6 and X.
1700 hrs	Range Closed for packing up
1730 hrs	Match debrief and BBQ at Petone Rifle Club.
NB. Seddon Range RSO Limits	Muzzle Energy less than 4500 Joules (3318 ft/lbs) Muzzle Velocity less than 1000 m/s (3274 f/s) Maximum calibre 0.312 inch

If the matches complete early, participants are welcome to enjoy more shooting at 500 yards prior to 1700 hrs, or retire to relax at Petone Rifle Club – cash bar will open once club shooting has concluded.
