1) Battle prep: 5 rds

Fig 12, prone unsupported, deliberate, 5 rounds in 1 minute.

2) Blitzkrieg – details of 5 shooters: 10 rds

Fig 12 standing unsupported snap, 5 exposures at ranges 90-80-70-60-50. Start rifle loaded with bolt closed on empty chamber at 100 mound. On command/whistle shooters have 15 seconds to move up 10 m and fire 2 shots into the Fig 12 to their front. Rifles reset to empty chamber between each exposure.

3) Stalingrad – *der Kessel (the Cauldron)*, close quarter battle at it's worst: 5 rds

Fig 12 snap, 5 x 4 second exposures from the standing unsupported at 50 m, 1rd per exposure. Start rifles at low port (in shoulder, muzzle down at ~30°) loaded and actioned.

4) Stalingrad – Sniper's kingdom: 5 rds

Fig 14 snap from the prone supported position (field rests allowed) at 100 m, 5 x 2 second exposures over the course of 2 minutes as directed by the RCO. Double score on each hit.

5) Kursk – The greatest tank battle: 10 rds

Steel plate and Tank target printed on A4 paper, deliberate from prone unsupported position at 100 m over 2 minutes. Steel plate to be knocked down first before Tank target can be engaged.

6) Berlin – Storm the Reichstag: 5 rds

Fig 14 snap from the standing position, 5 x exposures of 20 sec at 100-80-60-40-20 m ranges, 1 Rd per exposure. Each exposure starts on RCO's command and firers have 20 sec to move to the next firing point, load 1 rd and engage targets with 1 rd standing. Firers start in the loaded and actioned state at 100 m.

European, German or Russian WWII calibre rifles are eligible for Red Star/Eastern Front trophies , because, let's face it, both Germans and Russians used each-other's captured weapons in addition to their own. Read into that any 30 cal Mauser (Spanish, Portugese, Turkish etc) or Nagant is ok.

Alternatively matches could also be shot with a 303 for 303 Overall Trophy and Le Quesnoy (SMLE trophy)
